### FEBRUARY 2024

The Regal Investment Fund ("RF1") Net Asset Value ("NAV") increased by 5.1% to \$3.08 in February. Since inception on 17 June 2019, the Fund has generated 18.1% p.a. net of fees.<sup>1</sup>

February proved a positive month for global equity markets, with benchmark indices across the US, Japan, Europe and Australia all reaching fresh all-time highs. M&A activity and ECM deal flow increased significantly over the month, both domestically and offshore, as corporate management teams appear to grow more comfortable with the forward cost of funding and broadly improved sentiment regarding the health of underlying economies. Domestically, smaller and emerging industrial companies again saw positive returns (ASX Small Industrials increased +3.6%) with increasing evidence of capital flowing into the sector after a sustained period of underperformance versus larger cap counterparts.

Pleasingly, 7 of 8 underlying strategies contributed positively during February, with the Small Companies, Market Neutral and Emerging Companies strategies providing the strongest positive contributions for the month.


Within the Small Companies strategy, an overweight position in luxury ecommerce marketplace Cettire (+52%) was a positive contributor to returns, following the company releasing a 1H sales update well ahead of market expectations and flagging a positive start to the 2H. In the Market Neutral Strategy, positive updates from long positions in global equities asset manager GQG Partners (+16%) and critical infrastructure maintenance provider Ventia Services Group (+15%) also contributed positively to returns. Main detractors to performance this month included overweight positions in the Mining and Energy sectors, in line with broader weakness across commodity and energy markets.
